

# Institutional Support: UNESCO and FIBA

## General Info

In March 2012 both UNESCO and the International Federation of Basketball, granted the worldwide YMCA institutional support to the YMCA World Challenge.

This support does not imply any financial commitments from those organizations.

We thereby recommend YMCAs to use this institutional support to raise awareness and the credibility of the YMCA World Challenge as an important YMCA initiative to celebrate our work of empowering young people.

## The use of the logos

The logos of FIBA and UNESCO shall only be used by YMCAs involved in the YMCA World Challenge. The images can be used alongside YMCA logos with the text "worldwide partners", or equivalent in the local language.

The files are available by request and final publication and printing can only be undertaken with final approval of the World Alliance of YMCAs. Requests and approval can be arranged through the e-mail <a href="mailto:challenge@ymca.int">challenge@ymca.int</a>

It is mandatory that colors and proportions of the logos shall be preserved. The UNESCO logo can be used both in black and white colors.

**Important:** No communication material using the logos of the partners can include commercial brands. If the local YMCA has local sponsors, we recommend the design of alternative materials in addition to the ones containing the logo of the partners UNESCO and FIBA.
